

ENGLISH

This term, year 6 will be exploring dual narratives and carefully using speech to reveal more information about characters and advance the actions. The children will be creating dual narrative from the viewpoint of a swimmer at the beach and of a great-white shark

SCIENCE

This term the children will be exploring evolution and inheritance. They will learn about how characteristics are passed on through inheritance and why living things adapt to their surroundings. Also, the children will learn about the evolution of humans and Darwin's theory of evolution.

MATHS

Having worked extremely hard in the previous terms on their arithmetic, children will be exploring a variety of reasoning and problem solving questions in preparation for their SATs.

PSHE

Our unit of PSHE is the unit 'Being My Best'. We will be discussing where we see ourselves in 5,10 & 15 years and recognising the necessary steps to take to achieve our goals.

Music

In Music, Year 6 will be looking at how variation is used in Pop Art and in musical pieces to generate interest and excitement. Learners will also be creating their own variations of the same piece of music.
