We will be looking at Salsa music.

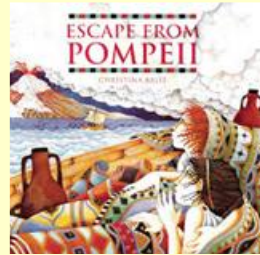
Computing

MATHS

Children will be continuing to develop their maths skills with particular focus on the following areas.

Fractions

- I can understand and show equivalent fractions
- I can count in fractional steps (halves, quarters, tenths and thirds) on a number-line.
- I can compare and order fractions with the same denominator
- I can add and subtract fractions

Geometry

- I can recognise angles as a property of a shape
- I can recognise that two right-angles make a half-turn, 3 a 3-quarter turn, 4 a complete turn
- Identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle

Addition and Subtraction

- I can add and subtract numbers with up to three digits.
- I understand that subtraction is the opposite of addition.
- I can read and write numbers up to 1000.
