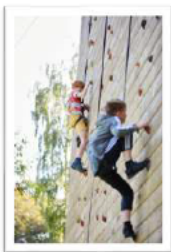
Nearer to the time we will provide you with details of clothing etc that your child will need to bring. **Transport will be provided by the school for no extra cost.**
