

ENGLISH

This term, year 6 will be looking at Shakespeare's 'Romeo & Juliet'. The children will be writing a newspaper article based on the street brawl and a letter from one of the characters.

The children will start reading 'Sky Hawk', a fantastic book about two children's secret discovery in the Scottish highlands.

The children will of course be sitting their English SATs.

SCIENCE

This term the children will be exploring the idea of evolution and inheritance. They will research and learn about how animals and humans have adapted over time to their environment in order to survive. The children will also be classifying living things.

RE

The children will be discussing and exploring the idea of 'sacred' and how this related to the idea of faith.

FRENCH

This term the children are looking at objects around the classrooms and items they might find around the school and how to write sentences grammatically correct.

MATHS

This half term Maths lessons will consist of practice SATs papers and revision of topic areas. The children will be challenging their reasoning skills supported by their workings.

The children will sit three SATs maths papers.

PE

Outdoor PE sessions will see the children taking learning how to play cricket. This will include learning the skills of batting, bowling and fielding.

PSHCE

The children will explore the idea of 'being my best' and what this actually means to them. This will take place using group discussions and individual activities.

COMPUTING

The children will continue to code this term using more sophisticated software.

DT and ART

The children will continue to design and build a working carnival ride into this term and also complete drawings of animals that have changed over time.
