## Maths

Children will be continue to develop their maths skills with particular focus on the following areas.

### Volume and Capacity:

- Measure, compare, add and subtract volume/capacity (l / ml)

### Multiplication and Division

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number
- Count from zero in multiples of 3,4,8,50 and 100
- Represent multiplication and division facts as arrays using a grid and a number-line
- Understand the links within and between tables facts

### Geometry

- Sort and classify 2-D and 3-D shapes using numbers of faces, edges and vertices.
- Know the names of common 3-D shapes
- Construct prisms and describe the shape of the faces.

## PE –Tuesday and Friday

Children will receive two sessions a week outdoors this term. We will be playing tag rugby and tennis.
