# Library News

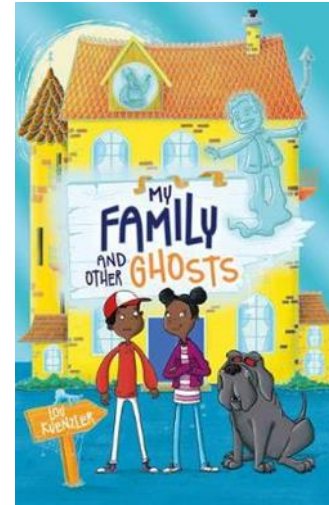


There are some exciting new books to borrow in the School Library. Over the next few weeks Mr Parkinson, our school librarian, will be sharing the books he's enjoyed the most!
