**Owls:** Jack and the Beanstalk has been the main story in Owls this week which inspired them to plant some beans - they have planted some into soil in pots and have some on wet cotton wool in the window. Owls also made jam sandwiches for their snack carefully following the instructions from the adults.

**Reception:** This week there has been great excitement as the caterpillars are now all in their chrysalis and the children are now eagerly waiting for butterflies to emerge. The children have been learning about the symmetrical patterns on butterflies and have made their own symmetrical patterns with paint and by putting cubes or pegs on a board. At the Junk Bar they have cut out circles to make 'The very hungry caterpillar' and have been challenged to use a different way to join each one, such as split pin, treasury tag, tape and string.

**Year 1:** Year 1 have had an astounding week and Mrs Cousins and Mrs O'Leary are super proud of all of the year again! Every day they have run with excitement and enthusiasm the golden mile, and taken part in so many different sports as part of Sports Week. There have been some incredible achievements, one Swan jumped 3 meters in the standing long jump, and one Woodpecker won all three distances in the Sprinting. They have also taken part in Netball, New Age Kurling and Football. Well done Year 1!

**Year 2:** Jays have had a great week and really enjoyed Sport's Week. The children have tried activities that they hadn't tried before and learned new skills. They loved the Golden Mile each morning and it was lovely to see so many parents supporting the class. Each day children have ridden their scooters to school and it has been such lovely weather that they have had plenty of opportunities to enjoy Scooter Week during the school days.

**Year 3:** This week, the children have really enjoyed being outside most of the day doing their Sports Week activities. They all have been resilient whilst doing their daily miles every morning and doing their personal challenges which have included javelin, speed jump, standing long jump, shuttle run, shot put and skipping. In the afternoons, the Year 3's have had fun preparing for the sprint final races and playing netball.

**Year 4:** Warwick and Windsor are enjoying their sports week activities as they demonstrate the importance of good sportsmanship as well as the school values of respect and collaboration in team sports. Inside the classroom, the children have been tackling mathematical and English-based investigations based on sporting themes such as 'The Riddle of the Swapped Signs'. Both classes are looking forward to the sports day activities on Friday to round off a very enjoyable week.

**Year 5:** Year 5 have really enjoyed taking part in all of the sports week activities. They have shown all of the Knight's Way values working in teams for the afternoon events and completing the personal challenge activities. They have been learning about their heart rates and have constructed line graphs to show how their heart rates increase after different types of exercise. The children have enjoyed their daily mile and have loved mums, dads and other family members joining them.

**Year 6:** In Year 6 this week, the children have been enjoying all of the wonderful activities on offer for Sports Week. In particular, learners have enjoyed the javelin and football tournament where they have had to compete within their houses. Students have also enjoyed taking part in the Daily Mile challenge each day and have liked over-taking their teachers multiple times when taking part!

**LEARN TO SWIM INTENSIVE SWIMMING COURSES**

Places Leisure and Test Valley Borough Council are keen to support more of the Borough's children to learn to swim and to also achieve the national curriculum target of being able to confidently swim 25m by the end of Year 6. Being able to swim is an important life skill and a great way to participate in sport and be physically active.

The Learn to Swim Intensive Swimming Course scheme is a series of daily swimming lessons that take place through a school holiday period and is aimed at school-aged children at beginner level. Places Leisure are pleased to be able to offer several intensive courses at Andover Leisure Centre during the school holidays and would like to offer your child a place. These courses usually cost £43 per person but are being offered to you at the subsidised rate of just **£32.50 per child**. Summer Intensive lessons are available on the below dates and between the below times:
