**Nursery:** Owlets: The colour green is the focus in Owlets this week and they have decorated crocodiles and frogs. Owls: It was an exciting time to see that most of the butterflies had emerged from their chrysalises this week - the children have enjoyed watching how they have fluttered around in the net and looked at what they notice about them. It was both sad and exciting to release them out to the wild so they could be free and find flowers!

**Reception:** This week all five of the chrysalis turned into butterflies. After watching them for a few days in the butterfly net, the children went onto the field to release them. All of the butterflies flew away as the children quietly waved. Last week the children all designed an obstacle course and this week they all took turns to build their course, using their plan, and then show others how to use it. In Literacy the children have worked collaboratively in a small group making up their own story. They decided on the setting and the characters then made up the story. They then made their own props before performing their story to the rest of the class.

**Year 1:** Year 1 have been looking at their senses this week in both English and Science. They had a session where they smelt, tasted, touched, listened and looked at other things and then wrote what they liked about each one. In Science they continued this by looking at which body part was responsible for each sense. In Maths, they have investigated weight and capacity. They used exciting glittery coloured water to measure out full, half full, empty, more than and less than.

**Year 2:** Year 2 had the best day ever this week when they visited Lepe Country Park on Wednesday! It was the hottest day of the year but ice creams cooled the children down as they built sandcastles and caught tiny crabs on the beach before visiting the beach classroom for a shaded picnic. They really enjoyed visiting the ocean where our stories of pirates, cutlasses and Jolly Roger shenanigans really came to life.....yo ho ho m' hearties, a great time was had by all!

**Year 3:** This week in Year 3 we have been doing our end of year tests! The children have been showing lots of independence and resilience so far and have given the tests their best effort! In the afternoons we have continuing with our non-core subjects. In geography, we have been exploring what seas and oceans surround the UK. In science we have learned about skeletons, identifying the differences between vertebrates and invertebrates and categorizing animals.

**Year 4:** This week, Year 4 have been completing their end of year assessments each morning. While this has been a new challenge, they have been extremely resilient and worked very hard! In the afternoons, Year 4 children have learning about different types of sport in French. They have also been learning about mythology in RE. This Friday, Warwick continued their art projects and Windsor continue their swimming lessons.

**Year 5:** Following our exertion in Sports Week, year 5 are back to learning all about space. In Science we are looking at the movement of the earth and the moon as we orbit the sun and in English, we have been writing about Venus by developing complex sentences using relative clauses. In Maths we are immersed in 'measures' and learning about the Maths involved in converting different measurements. Maybe the children could do some baking at home to put their knowledge of measures to the test!

**Year 6:** In Year 6 this week, children have been busy rehearsing their parts for their end of year production. The songs are sounding amazing now students are starting to learn their lines off by heart. In English, learners have been writing letters to Albus Dumbledore asking for advice on a new creature they have found. In Maths, children have been re-capping their knowledge of shape and measure, using protractors and rulers effectively. They've even been instructing each other on how to draw shapes accurately!

**LEARN TO SWIM INTENSIVE SWIMMING COURSES**

Places Leisure and Test Valley Borough Council are keen to support more of the Borough's children to learn to swim and to also achieve the national curriculum target of being able to confidently swim 25m by the end of Year 6. Being able to swim is an important life skill and a great way to participate in sport and be physically active.

The Learn to Swim Intensive Swimming Course scheme is a series of daily swimming lessons that take place through a school holiday period and is aimed at school-aged children at beginner level. Places Leisure are pleased to be able to offer several intensive courses at Andover Leisure Centre during the school holidays and would like to offer your child a place. These courses usually cost £43 per person but are being offered to you at the subsidised rate of just **£32.50 per child**.
