Just over One week left and the children are still doing their very best. I wanted to give a big shout out to Year 6. The children have been practicing their performance over the last few weeks, and this week they shared their performance to both schools and their families. They all did amazing Well Done.

**Nursery:** Owlets: The focus in Owlets this week was the colour purple. They have been watering their cress to make sure it grows properly. Owls: The Crunching, Munching Caterpillar is the book that Owls have enjoyed this week - they made links to the story of the Very Hungry Caterpillar and knew that the caterpillar was going to turn into a butterfly. They explored different ways to make marks with paint - but the favourite way was with their hands!

**Reception:** It has been a week of healthy eating in Reception! The children have harvested some of the vegetables they have been growing. Some children wrote a list of ingredients and instructions for making vegetable soup. They then used safety knives to cut the vegetables up. These were then cooked before the children all had the opportunity to taste the soup with some bread during snack time. The children have been learning about foods that are healthy and foods that are treats. As part of this they have designed healthy fruit minibeasts, carefully cutting the fruits to the shapes they needed and assembling their minibeasts. They then enjoyed eating it!

**Year 1:** Year One have enjoyed looking at the story of Jack and the beanstalk this week. They've answered questions on the text and rewritten parts of the story in their own words. In maths they've looked at 2D and 3D shape as one of the last parts of their maths learning this year. They went to watch the Year 6 show rehearsal, had an afternoon with Openbox Theatre and a special suitcase delivery from the Titanic.

**Year 2:** Jays had a fantastic pirate day on Thursday! The children thoroughly enjoyed an interactive theatre experience with a visit from the Openbox Theatre. They applied their learning about the habits and behaviours of dastardly pirates, to solve the clues and to open the

treasure chest. The children then enjoyed a pirate party afternoon with a pirate picnic followed by cannonball battles on the high seas, with 'misbehaving' pirates being 'made' to walk the plank over treacherous, shark infested seas!

In other news, the children were introduced to their new rich text 'Clean Up!' by Nathan Bryon. They wrote predictions and questions before enjoying the book together. In maths the children have revisited measure, accurately measuring length, mass, capacity and temperatures this week.

**Year 3:** This week in maths we have been exploring division using arrays and bar models. We have had lots of active maths lessons, using whiteboards and joining in class maths games looking at division as the inverse of multiplication. In English we have been planning on writing an advert to persuade others to buy our own chocolate bars! This week we have designed our bars, and are now going to use persuasive writing techniques such as alliteration and rhetorical questions to sell them! In science, we have looked at muscles and how our bodies move. We made a working arm, using a pin to show where the joints meet and how our arms hinge and move.

**Year 4:** Year 4 have started their new learning journey on The Guardians of the Planet, which encourages children to become eco-heroes saving the environment! This week has seen the children venture into the wooded area to do a Forest School session on leaf and bark rubbings, which will help them to identify the plants in our school. Maths is now focusing on measuring length and converting different units. Lastly, the children have completed a detailed drawing of a creature in the style of Charles Darwin, which has been a lot of fun.

**Year 5:** Year 5 have been working very hard this week. We have been writing our space texts about Jupiter and learning about translation and reflection in maths. On Wednesday, we had the opportunity to go to Winton for the day and do lots of art, drama and music activities. We are all very excited for our last full week in year 5 next week!

**Year 6:** In Year 6 this week, the children have been working hard on their final rehearsals for their end of year production: 'The School-O-Vision Song Contest'. Across the week, pupils have performed their show to all children in the school from Year R all the way to Year 5, with a final performance to parents last night. The Year 6 children have made us all proud with their outstanding independence, collaboration and resilience this week and have put on a show to remember. Well done Year 6!
