We haven't got long before the end of term and it seems to be getting busier each week. We started off the week with the library service coming in for an assembly to discuss the Summer Reading Challenge. Thank you to all the parents who joined us. Also on Thursday, Year 3 went to Anton Lakes and Year 5 went for a taster day at Harrow Way. Finally, Funky Friday is back and the children enjoyed loud music of their choice in the morning, break, lunch and at the end of the day.

Year 3: Year 3 have had a fabulous trip to Anton Lakes this week. All the adults were very proud of their behaviour and interest in their learning. In school, the children have been publishing and performing their poems. The children have worked hard and their poems are individual and brilliant.

Year 4: This week Year 4 have been getting stuck into their vivid descriptions of a gloomy setting from 'the Promise'. The teachers have been astounded by the rich language of these carefully crafted setting descriptions. As Year 4 move forward with the editing phase, they are enjoying sharing more of these writing pieces with each other. In Maths this week we have been revisiting addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers. They have been looking at the relationship between these two concepts and solidifying their understanding of the column method. Last of all, members of Warwick class have been working tirelessly to create paper flowers for the Carnival - even using their free time to contribute to the enchanted garden themed float.

Year 5: Year 5 attended a 'taster' day at Harrow Way school and sampled life at secondary school. Both classes enjoyed English, Science and Design and Technology sample lessons. One highlight was mixing different chemicals to produce fizzing reactions! In maths, the children have been consolidating their knowledge of degrees of turn while in English a lot of interest us being created by Matthew's Henson's journey to the North Pole.

Year 6: Year 6 have had an extremely busy but enjoyable week. They have practised, refined and performed their wonderful talent show to parents and the rest of the school. The children were so proud to be able to show off their individual talents to everyone and showed a huge amount of effort and courage. In between rehearsals, they were able to fit in an archaeological trip to Harmony woods! They learned how to excavate a trench, sieve for Bronze Age artefacts and dye clothes using plant products.

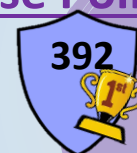


