On Thursday, the children promoted Clean Air Day by scootering around the playground in afternoon. On Tuesday, Year 5 had their science museum trip which they loved and proudly represented the school. On Wednesday, the Multiply Parents Maths sessions started which was very positive. On Thursday, the Curling team represented the school and came 1st and 3rd. Finally, today the children enjoyed Funky Friday, Year 5 had an Animal Aid Talk and our Rounders Teams did well in the afternoon competition. Wow – that is it for this week...

Year 3: The week started with a trip to the woods to light a fire! This was because the children were reading a poem called 'Fireplace'. The children sat around the fire and observed it carefully and thought about how they would describe the experience in their own poems. The next day, the children wrote some fabulous fire poems with some really interesting ideas and great language choices. In maths this week, the children have learnt how to use column method for subtraction. They have worked really hard to record their calculations neatly in their books.

Year 4: In English, Year 4 have been looking at the different writing skills required to write a setting description. To support this the students have been using images from the book called 'The Promise'.

During Maths, The classes have been working hard doing different times table activities. The students have enjoyed getting competitive on TT Rockstars and drawing multiplication grids in chalk on the playground.

Also this week, Year 4 continued their Computing unit of work based around animation. The students have shown a really good understanding of how these can be created using various images. Year 4 are really looking forward to 'Sports Week' next week. We hope lots of our parents can join us every day for the daily mile.

Year 5: Year 5 have had a busy week. On Monday they took part in an online road safety session discussing ways to keep safe when walking and cycling. On Tuesday they had an amazing day at the Winchester Science Centre. The children took part in a workshop, watched a presentation in the Planetarium and had time to explore all of the hands-on exhibits. They have been continuing their fractions work, learning how to multiply fractions in maths and writing non-chronological reports about planets in English. On Friday we have a visitor coming into school to give an Animal Aid talk.

Year 6: This week Year 6 have started their new writing topic, Wonder. They have been exploring the themes of identity, friendship and change and discussing techniques the author uses to express these. In Maths, the children have been preparing for next year by looking at formula, expression and algebra. They have enjoyed forest school activities outside in the sunshine.
