Online Safety: Cyberflashing

'**Cyberflashing**' is where somebody digitally sends sexual images or pornography to an unsuspecting person. Due to the nature of channels used to send these images, the victim will not know they have been cyberflashed until they have actively opened the notification or gone into the app.

AirDrop is a file and image sharing app, bespoke for Apple devices, which enables users to drop content for nearby devices to accept or reject. Cyberflashing most commonly occurs using Apple AirDrop, as strangers can send images to a victim's phone without having their details saved. Cyberflashing can also occur through **file sharing apps** and **social media**, especially if the perpetrator has the victim's details.

Best practices for parents and carers (preventative):

Discuss boundaries and encourage open communication

Tell your child that their boundaries are valid and that if anything breaks those boundaries – whether strangers inside or outside of school; or even close friends or partners – then they should speak to you or a trusted adult about it straight away. Make sure that they know you will support them without judgement no matter what happens.

Check your child's AirDrop settings

If your child has an iPhone, check their AirDrop settings with them (Settings > General > AirDrop) and, if necessary, take a look at their privacy settings. The default is set to "Everyone", meaning anyone nearby can send unsolicited photos straight to your child's phone. We recommend switching to "Contacts Only" so that only friends can send photos, or even "Receiving Off" if you and your child decide this is the safest option for them.

Establish safety features of other apps

Cyberflashing still occurs through social media and file sharing apps when privacy and safety features have not been enabled. Look through your child's apps with them and set privacy settings to "friends only"; be selective about who can follow them or they can follow. We recommend using our partner Childnet's "[My Life Online](#)" conversation guide to facilitate conversation and establish rules.

In maths we have been focusing on consolidating our knowledge, making sure to use problem solving skills and number sequencing. We cannot believe how quickly the year has flown by. Well done Puffins and Robins! Keep it up.

Year 2: Year 2 have had a fabulous couple of weeks with lots of learning and lots of fun! Last week the children had a great day at Lepe Beach, they made us extremely proud showing the Knights' Way throughout the day. Luckily, it was a cooler day so they played on the beach before lunch and enjoyed the adventure park after lunch. Our day was an introduction to our new learning about plastic waste in our oceans. The children enjoyed our new rich text 'Clean Up!' by Nathan Bryon. On Thursday the children enjoyed our Pirate Day, full of fun, treats and 'Ahoy there's!' We even had a cannonball fight! This week ended beautifully with our second Bump Up day when all the children met up again with their new class and their new teachers.

Year 3: In English, we have been doing a mini project to recap everything we have learnt this year by writing advice cards/top tips for the new year 3s coming up. The children have really enjoyed thinking about the year they have had and remembering everything they have done (which is a lot!). In Maths, we have been using all of our resilience to practise expanded method in multiplication and division by multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers. In DT, we evaluated scones to try and improve them and then baked cheese scones which the children had great fun doing!

Year 4: In English, the students have been writing up their setting descriptions based on the book 'The Promise'. They used lots of adjectives to describe the various nouns within the story. During Maths, the classes have been focusing on fractions. This has involved the students understanding equivalent fractions and working out how to solve problems involving quantities of amounts. Also, in French, the students completed a pole to find out other people's favourite sports. This involved lots of oral communication in French. Finally, the classes really enjoyed taking part in small-sided rounders matches this week. This enabled them to apply all the batting and fielding skills they have learnt this half-term.

Year 5: This week Year 5 have been writing some stunning moon themed poetry, and getting outside to draw mathematically accurate rectangles - then figuring out the perimeter. Everybody in Year 5 enjoyed the Year 6 performance and thought the jokes were hilarious, especially the part where Miss Williams and Mrs Cameron had 'real' grubs dumped on their heads! Good luck to Year 6 for the real thing.

Year 6: In Year 6 this week, pupils have blown us all away with their performances of 'I'm An 11-Year-Old, Get Me Out Of Here'. Having to deliver 3 performances to their peers and to adults, the children have shown tremendous resilience, independence and collaboration to make it a phenomenal show! We are all incredibly proud of their hard work in learning their lines and practicing the songs - it is clear we have many amazing actors in our school!

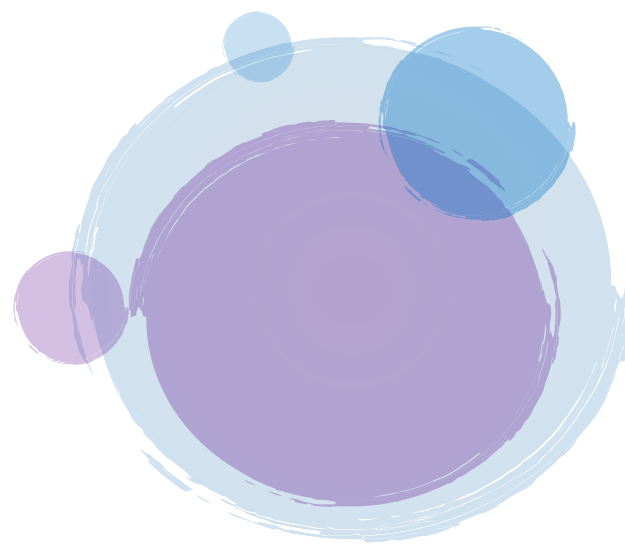
