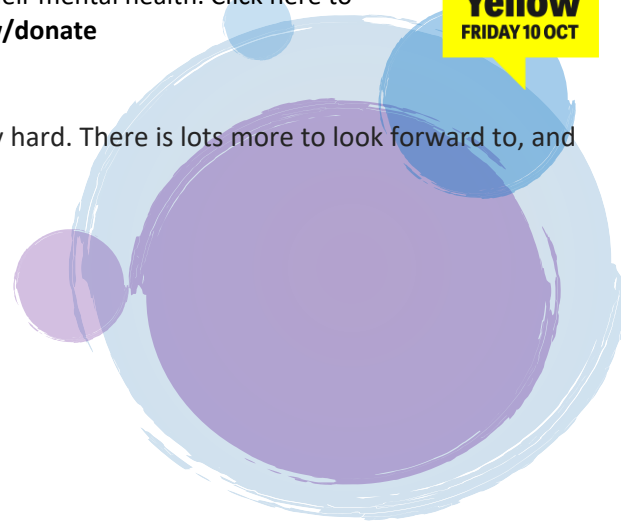

You can track your child's attendance on the Arbor App

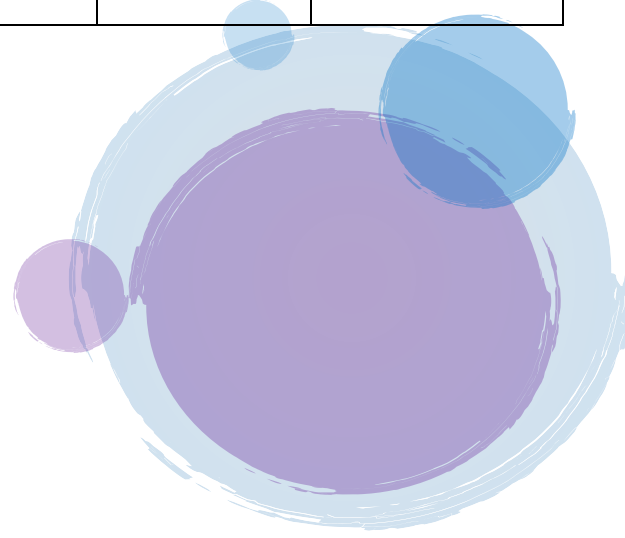
If you have any questions regarding attendance, you can speak to Ms Hardy who is based at the Infants.

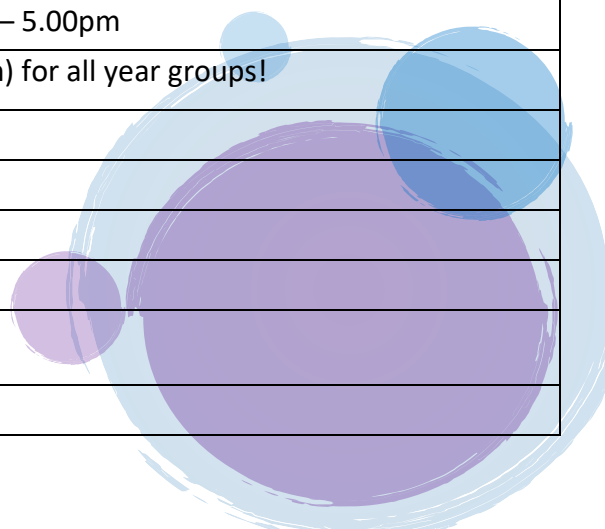

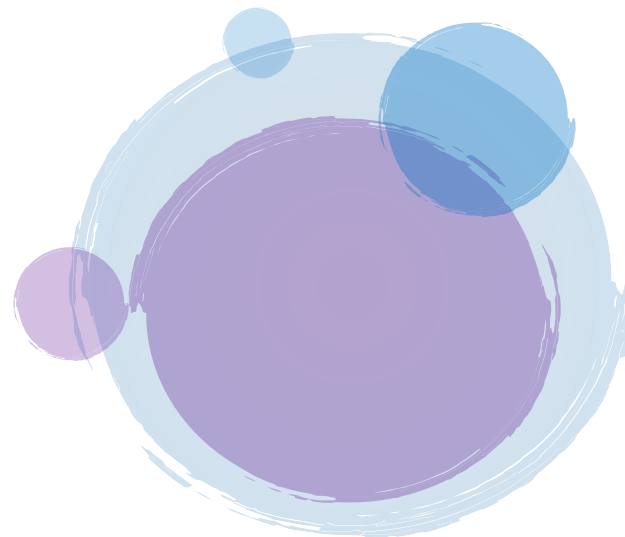
