Children will receive two sessions a week. Our first session in the week will be Ball Skills and our second session is gymnastics using the apparatus!

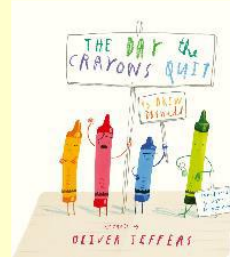
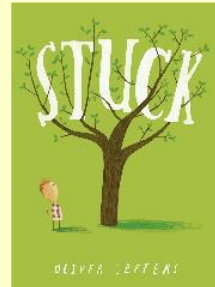

ENGLISH

We will be continuing to deepen pupils understanding of numbers, and modelling and encouraging increased fluency.

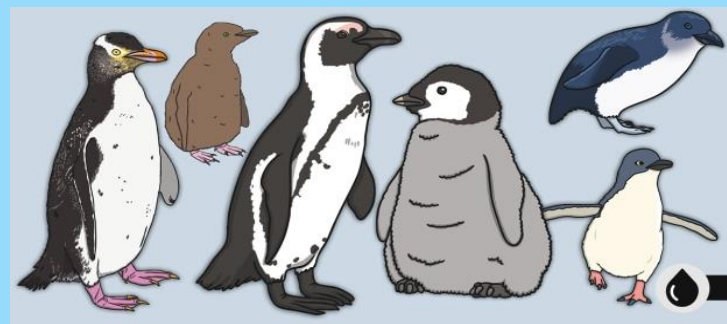
Statistics
