

PRIME AREAS:

This half term we will be singing lots of nursery rhymes and using some Makaton signs alongside them. Search 'Singing Hands' and 'Mr Tumble' to help learn some different Makaton signs at home.

We will be learning all about the routines and expectations of coming to school including where we put our bottles, hang up our coats and how to sit on the carpet for stories and singing.

We will practise taking off our shoes and putting on waterproofs and wellies so we can play outside with the water and in the muddy kitchen.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

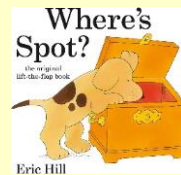
We will use the different people in our dolls house to help us to talk about people in our families and look at how families are all different. Our home corner will help us to take on different roles and think about how we look after babies.

We will draw pictures of ourselves and talk about our families – you could send in pictures on Tapestry that we can look at with the children together!

We will explore our new environment including the library and visit the ducks and chickens!

LITERACY

We will be using these texts, among many others, to discuss and to develop our vocabulary including talking about positional language (in, on, under etc.), colours, emotions and joining in with familiar phrases (I'll huff, and I'll puff...).



In our phonics we will be looking at how to make different sounds with instruments or our bodies (clapping, stamping & making different sounds with our mouths!). We will think about how to make sounds louder or quieter and trying to copy what an adult shows us.

MATHS

We will learn about different maths concepts through our discovery time as well as through singing different number songs and practising counting. We will start looking at how to count carefully by moving one object at a time or pointing to each thing as we count it.

How can you help?

- pointing out numbers in the environment (door numbers, numbers on the bins, numbers you spot on packets).
- count out simple things at home, e.g. How many socks are we putting on? Can you put 5 pieces of cucumber on your plate?
- watching Numberblocks and Colourblocks on BBC iPlayer together and talking about what's happening.
