PE -Please check website for updated PE days for each class.

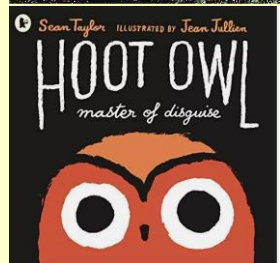
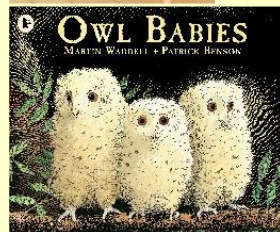
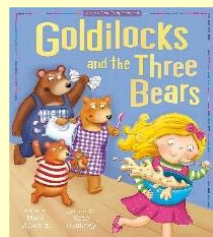
