

### Anti- Bullying

- We learn about being a good friend, remembering our kind hands and feet and always using kind words.
- We understand how to say 'no' and 'stop' when we are not comfortable with others behaviour
- We learn how to ask for help when stuck, and talk to the people in the room

**Teachable moments can happen during anti-Bullying week, circle times, play times and when sharing stories.**

### Keeping Safe

- We learn about how I keep myself safe
- We learn about how my family and trusted adults keep me safe.
- We learn about the people outside of school that can help me.
- We learn about the difference between a 'stranger' and 'someone who can help'.
- Learning about being safe near the roads

**Teachable moments can happen during SCARF sessions, carpet times and school trips.**

### E-Safety

- We are learning our SMART rules
- We are learning about what is safe to play and what might be harmful
- We are learning not to give people information online/ when playing a game
- We are learning about what to do if I am worried about what I see online.

**Teachable moments can happen during E-Safety week, carpet times and when accessing online with adult support.**

### Awareness of other cultures

- We learn how to show respect for others through our school core values.
- We learn about others' beliefs, religions and celebrations within our own community and those around the world.
- We learn about and celebrate festivals of different faiths.

**Teachable moments can happen during SCARF sessions and whole school assemblies.**



## EYFS

### British Values

- We take part in weekly school value (Respect, Nurture, Resilience, Collaboration and Independence) assemblies and celebrations
- We learn how to show respect for others
- We learn, talk about and use British values within class discussion (democracy, rule of law, individual liberty, tolerance of different faiths and beliefs and mutual respect)
- We learn about our rights and responsibilities

**Teachable moments can happen during assemblies, carpet times, play times, whilst sharing stories or talking about our experiences (such as when looking through photographs and videos from home via Tapestry).**

### Relationships

- We learn about our emotions, find ways to express them appropriately and talk about the feelings that may not be good for us.
- We show empathy for others and help them when they are feeling sad
- We are aware of how our actions can affect other in the class
- We learn about people who are special to me

**Teachable moments can happen during anti-bullying week, carpet times, SCARF Sessions, playtimes and parent interactions.**

### Road Safety

- We learn the basic road safety rules including but not limited to: holding hands, looking both ways before crossing, listening to and staying with an adult, finding safe places to cross and the red man/ green man walkways.
- We take opportunities to practice road safety
- We learn how to ride bikes safely and properly following the road safety rules

**Teachable moments can happen during Bikeability, road safety week, carpet times and be bright be seen day.**

### Health and wellbeing

- We learn about healthy and unhealthy foods
- We talk about keeping our teeth and mouth healthy
- We learn how to have and maintain good personal hygiene
- We learn the names for different body parts, differences between boys and girls and our own personal privacy
- We understand that our choices can have consequences

**Teachable moments can happen during assemblies, cooking, sporting opportunities, oral hygiene talks and SCARF sessions.**
