

Anti- Bullying

Year 5 will be exposed to continuing dialogue about bullying: how to recognise it, how to prevent it and what to do if it happens to them or their friends.

We follow the SCARF programme in PSHE to highlight the importance of this.

Awareness of other cultures

We are a culturally diverse school. The variety of languages and backgrounds in our classes is valued and celebrated.

In RE lessons in Year 5, we learn about Islam and Christianity and how people of these faiths incorporate their values and celebrate their customs. Where possible, we link this with pupil's personal experiences.

Relationships

In Year 5, we discuss with the children the changes which happen to their bodies in puberty.

They will be learning why these changes happen and understand that it is completely normal and something that all children experience.

Keeping Safe

Children will have the opportunity to go on school trips and local visits.

We will emphasise with the children what they need to do to safe when out in the community and beyond the school grounds.

Road Safety

The school JRSOs lead an assembly and promote understanding of the importance of keeping safe on the road as a pedestrian and as a cyclist.

E-Safety

In ICT, we learn how to keep safe, including: playing games and we refresh this at the beginning of every ICT learning journey. E-safety is also discussed in detail on internet safety day.

British Vales

We focus on the most important aspects of British culture and values, such as: democracy and freedoms of speech and religion.

We encourage the children to be tolerant, understanding and respectful towards each other.

Health and wellbeing

Children will learn to reflect on and celebrate their achievements, identify their strengths, take ownership of their targets and set high aspirations and goals.

They are encouraged to maintain a healthy lifestyle through a balanced diet and regular exercise.
