## Online Safety


### ROBLOX - Key Safety & Parental Controls:

**Set Up & Secure:** Create a parental account, add your email to the child's account, and create a 4-digit PIN in the **Settings > Security** menu to prevent changes.


**Content Restrictions:** In **Settings > Privacy**, adjust the "Content Maturity" to age-appropriate levels (e.g., 'Minimal' is the most restrictive) to control which games can be played.

**Chat & Privacy Settings:** Limit who can chat with your child (e.g., to "Friends Only" or turn it off entirely) to prevent unwanted contact from strangers

**Verify Age:** Ensure your child's birthdate is accurate to trigger appropriate safety filters.

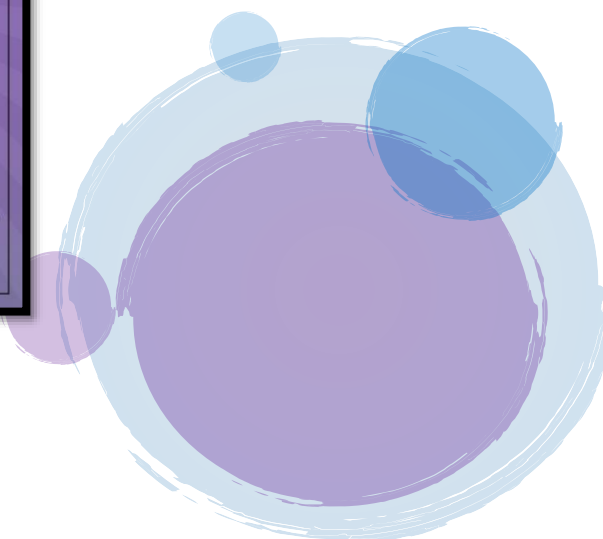

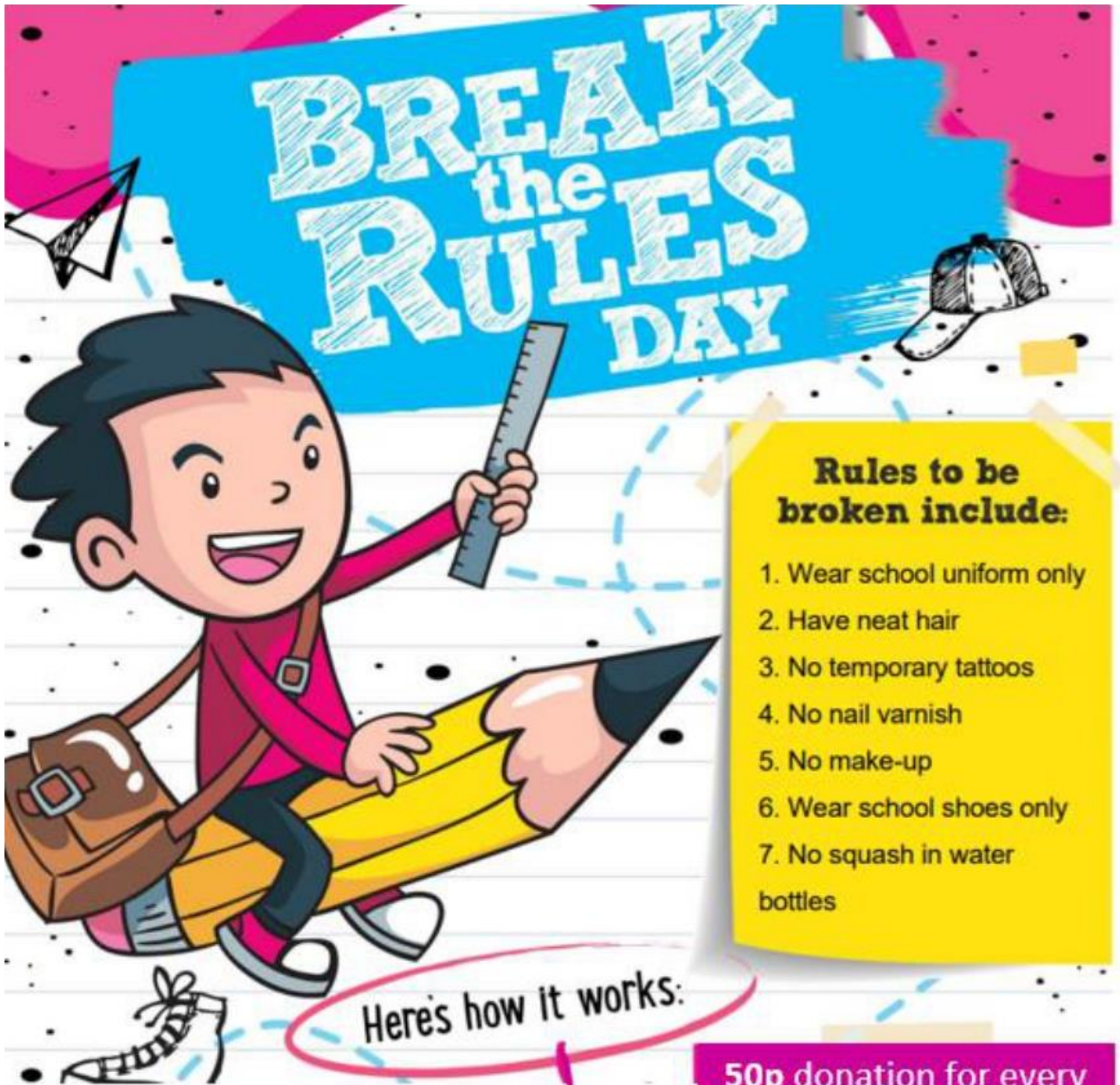
