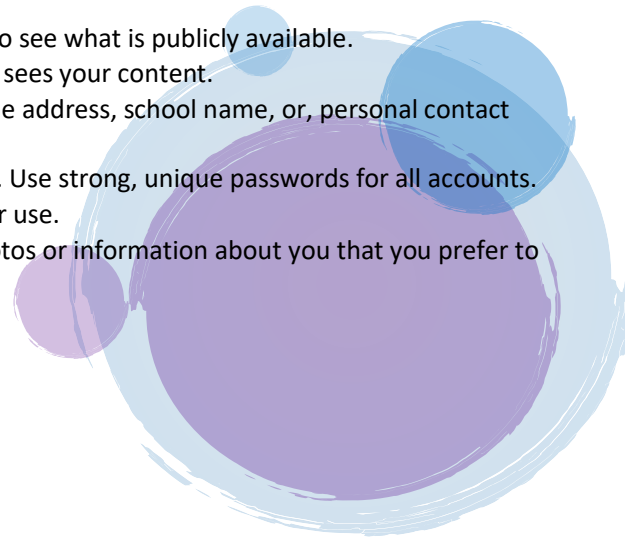

- Search Yourself: Regularly search your name or username in search engines to see what is publicly available.
- Tighten Privacy Settings: Set social media profiles to "private" to control who sees your content.
- Think Before You Post: Avoid sharing sensitive information, such as your home address, school name, or, personal contact details.
- Secure Devices & Apps: Review app permissions for tracking and geolocation. Use strong, unique passwords for all accounts.
- Clean Up Old Accounts: Delete, deactivate, or lock old accounts you no longer use.
- Manage Others' Posts: Ask friends and family not to share, or to remove, photos or information about you that you prefer to keep private
