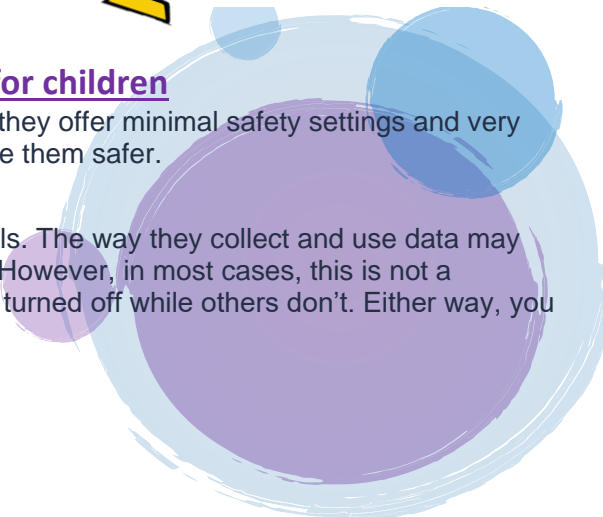


## Online Safety - How to make AI safer for children

Most mainstream AI platforms weren't designed with children in mind. As such, they offer minimal safety settings and very few options for parents specifically. But there are still steps you can take to make them safer.

### Turn off data collection

Popular AI platforms may collect data from users to continue improving their tools. The way they collect and use data may differ between platforms. You can explore their privacy policies to learn how. However, in most cases, this is not a requirement to use the platform. Some platforms automatically have this setting turned off while others don't. Either way, you can usually go to 'Settings' or 'Privacy' on the platform to customise this.

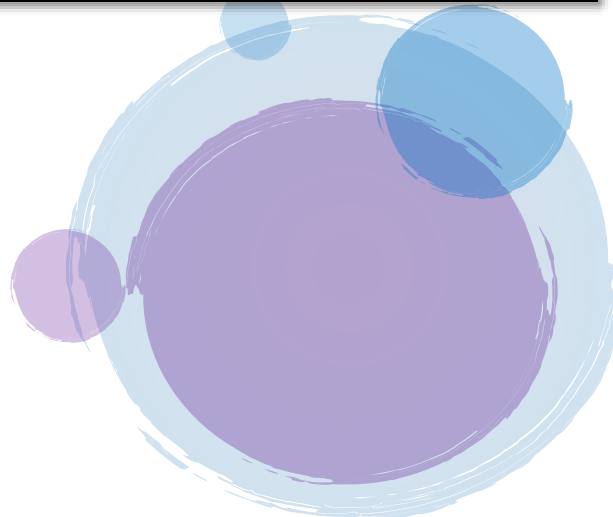
