WhatsApp is one of the most popular messaging apps in the world, with more than 1.5 billion people in more than 180 countries using it to send and receive text, photos, videos and documents, as well as make voice and video calls through its internet or Wi-Fi connection. The app also offers end-to-end encryption, which means that messages can only be read by the sender and the recipient, or one-to-one chats, or all members if it is a group chat. But there are risks to using the app.

What parents need to know about WhatsApp

AGE LIMIT CHANGE
From May 2018, the minimum age for using WhatsApp is 16 years old. This is to protect children from the potential risks of the app, such as cyberbullying, sexting, and contact with strangers. Parents should ensure their child is not using the app before they are 16.

FAKE NEWS AND HOAXES
WhatsApp has been used to spread fake news and hoaxes, which can be harmful to individuals and communities. Parents should encourage their child to be critical of what they see on the app and not to share anything without checking it first.

CONNECTING WITH STRANGERS
WhatsApp allows users to connect with people they don't know, which can be dangerous. Parents should ensure their child only adds people they know and are comfortable with.

LIVE LOCATION SHARING
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to share their live location with others. Parents should ensure their child understands the risks of sharing their location and only does so if they are comfortable with it.

SCAM MESSAGES
WhatsApp has been used to send scam messages, which can be harmful to individuals and communities. Parents should encourage their child to be critical of what they see on the app and not to share anything without checking it first.

THE ONLY ADMIN FEATURE
WhatsApp has a feature that allows the admin of a group chat to remove members. Parents should ensure their child understands the risks of being an admin and only does so if they are comfortable with it.

REPORT SCAM MESSAGES
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to report scam messages. Parents should encourage their child to report any suspicious messages to the app.

DELETE ACCIDENTAL MESSAGES
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to delete messages. Parents should encourage their child to be careful when deleting messages and not to delete anything important.

SET TIME LIMITS
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to set time limits for how long they can use the app. Parents should encourage their child to set a time limit for how long they can use the app.

USING LIVE LOCATION SAFELY
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to share their live location. Parents should ensure their child understands the risks of sharing their location and only does so if they are comfortable with it.

LEAVE A GROUP
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to leave a group chat. Parents should encourage their child to leave a group chat if they are not comfortable with it.

EXPLAIN HOW TO BLOCK PEOPLE
WhatsApp has a feature that allows users to block people. Parents should encourage their child to block anyone who is harassing them or sending them unwanted messages.
