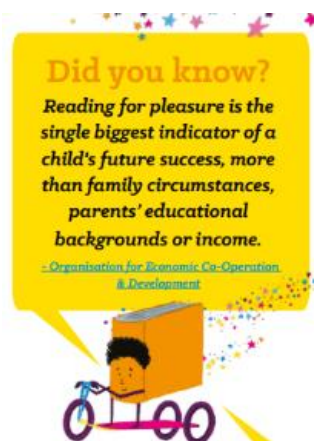
There's lots of great ideas about how families can be involved on the World Book Day website including free video and audio books, so do have a look.
